

Vaccine support for EMPAVELI

Before starting your treatment journey with EMPAVELI, you will need to get certain vaccines.



What vaccines do I need?

At least 2 weeks before your first dose of EMPAVELI, complete or update your vaccinations against *Streptococcus pneumoniae* and *Neisseria meningitidis*.

You may need the following vaccines:

- ▶ Pneumococcal vaccination(s)
- ▶ Meningococcal vaccinations
 - ▶ MenACWY series
 - ▶ MenB series



Where can I get these vaccinations?

Start by talking to your healthcare provider to see if they offer the vaccines.

You may also receive these vaccines at:

- ▶ Retail pharmacies
- ▶ Health clinics
- ▶ Local health department
- ▶ Your home

Tips for getting your vaccinations



Determine how to get your vaccinations

- ▶ Speak with your healthcare provider and see if they offer the recommended vaccinations, or
- ▶ Work with ApellisAssist to explore additional vaccination options that best fit your needs, such as a local pharmacy or an in-home vaccination appointment



Once you get your vaccinations

- ▶ Request a copy of vaccines received and keep for your records
- ▶ Share your vaccination record with your healthcare provider
- ▶ Make follow-up appointments for vaccinations that are part of a multi-dose series

A **Vaccine Coordinator** can:

- ▶ Find a local vaccination site based on insurance coverage, transfer prescriptions to selected pharmacy, and confirm billing information
- ▶ Coordinate shipment of the vaccines to your healthcare provider's office
- ▶ Arrange an in-home vaccination appointment with a professional nursing service



A **Care Coordinator** can:

- ▶ Help you schedule your deliveries for medication and supplies
- ▶ Explain your insurance benefits or available financial assistance options, if you are eligible



An **Apellis Care Coordinator (ACE)** can:

- ▶ Give 1-on-1 training on how to self-administer EMPAVELI either in your home or virtually
- ▶ Provide a wide variety of educational resources
- ▶ Offer ongoing support every step of the way
